Our Goal

Our Goal is to sell 325 tickets and raise \$50,000 to continue SAC's mission to provide healing for children, adults and families affected by sexual assault and to end sexual violence through counseling, education and advocacy. This mission is only possible because of generous, caring people like you! We are also excited to highlight some awesome local businesses.

April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month, so another goal is to spread prevention information. An SAC discussion guide and informational materials will come with the meal as well for those who would like to learn more or discuss this important topic with their friends or family over dinner.

Meal Information

Each ticket includes a full meal for two.

- ✓ Fresh Salad – Vendor can choose the type of salad that best fits with the entrée. Approximate budget per ticket – \$2.50
- ✓ Bread – Vendor can choose type of bread or roll that fits best with the entrée. Approximate budget per ticket - \$1.50
- ✓ Standard Entrée – Vendor can choose a refrigerated heat and serve or frozen bake and serve. Approximate budget per ticket - \$11.00
- ✓ Alternate Entrée – This needs to be a vegan, gluten free and nut free meal. Approximate budget per ticket - \$11.00
- ✓ Dessert – Vendor can choose the dessert that best fits with the entrée, can be heat and serve or cold. Approximate budget per ticket - \$2.00
- ✓ Bottle of Wine – Vendor can choose between a sparkling wine/champaign or a red and white table blend. Approximate budget per bottle - \$3.00
- ✓ Sparkling Cider – Vendor can choose the type of cider as long as it is non-alcoholic. Approximate budget per bottle - \$3.00
- ✓ Cooler Bag – It needs to be insulated with a customizable side to add sponsors and also have a pocket. Colors may vary but must match the event or SAC's logos. Approximate budget per bag - \$3.00

Additional Vendor Information

- Ideally, each vendor can store the food items until the morning of the event. SAC has extremely limited refrigerator and freezer space.
- Items can either be picked up by volunteers or delivered by the vendors.
- We want to work with each vendor to give as much creative liberty as possible so please let us know your ideas on how we can make this the best meal our donors can get while highlighting the flavor of your business.
- All vendors and menu items must be confirmed no later than January 31, 2021
