- Position:** SAC Accompaniment Advocate-Weekend Shift
- Purpose:** To provide medical accompaniment, information, support, and resources to SAC clients
- Reports To:** Crisis Support Supervisor

Major Duties Include:

- Participate in Medical Accompaniment Program by assuming clinic coverage responsibilities to respond to rape victims seeking medical legal exams in Davidson County;
- To maintain appropriate and thorough documentation and electronic records;
- Attend Criminal Injuries Victims Compensation training every 3 years;
- Attend regularly scheduled Advocacy Team meetings;
- Attend SAC all staff meeting monthly
- Other duties assigned.

Part time. Weekend shift 6a-6p or 6p-6a Saturday and Sunday

- Experience working within diverse communities required.
- Experience working with sexual assault victims/survivors and/or systems/organizations working on behalf of sexual assault victims/survivors preferred.
- Experience working in or with health care setting preferred.
- Bilingual preferred.
