



POSITION DESCRIPTION: BILINGUAL CONTRACT CLINICAL THERAPIST

Position: Bilingual Contract Clinical Therapist (Contract Fee for Service)

Reports To: Clinical Director

Purpose: Provide direct clinical support to clients including crisis intervention, therapy, advocacy, psychoeducation and referrals to support healing from the impact of sexual assault in their lives.

Job Type: Contract Fee for Service. Rate of \$60.00 per session. Contractor to see 1-15 clients, as their capacity allows.

Major Duties Include:

- Provide quality and effective individual therapy to assigned clients, on site at the Sexual Assault Center, and at the Family Safety Center, serving clients in the Cherished Hearts Program.
- Work collaboratively with Family Safety Center/Cherished Hearts staff to maximize positive outcomes for clients.
- Maintain a full caseload of clients seeking therapeutic services.
- Keep accurate client records and complete appropriate documentation in a timely manner.
- Work collaboratively with SAC Advocates, in support of client needs.
- Support peers by participating in weekly Clinical Team meeting and case staffing.
- Actively participate in individual clinical supervision.
- Engage in outreach and community-based activities as needed.
- Collaborate with other teams within the Sexual Assault Center, such as intake, advocacy, prevention, training, the SAFE Clinic, and the state-wide crisis line, on agency initiatives as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Graduation from an accredited college or university with a master's degree in social work, Psychology, or Counseling.
- Active TN Health Related Board independent clinical license.
- Experience with trauma informed care.
- Bilingual Clinical Therapist (English and Spanish).

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience with the sexual assault survivor population.
- Minimum of 3 years of post-graduate clinical experience.

SAC reserves the right to waive any of the above qualifications dependent on work experience and other qualifying factors.

Competencies:

- Experience and comfort with providing support and care to survivors of sexual assault.
- Ability to provide compassionate, culturally aware and effective care for a diverse population of clients.
- Competence commensurate with experience, providing therapy to clients of various ages, including children, adolescents, and adults.
- Strong self and “we” care strategies to support healthy well-being of self.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office Suite (Outlook, Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
- Ability to navigate electronic record keeping systems.
- Bi-lingual (English/Spanish) required.
